Log data:

As soon as the website is accessed, some data is stored in the logs. We therefore receive technical information about the origin (usually; country of origin) of the website access, about the exact IP addresses, about the operating system used, about the browser used and about the possible source of origin. However, we do not use any other functions to combine this information with data from other sources. We also do not make this information available to any external operator. We also do not use any Google analysis tools that may pass on your data.
